Graduation Requirements - In order to receive a state diploma, students must earn a total of 24 Carnegie units. Those units are specified by subject area as follows: 4 - English, 4 - Mathematics, 1 - US History, .5 - Economics, .5 - Government, 1 - Other Social Studies, 3 - Natural Science, 1 - Foreign Language/CATE, 1 – Physical Education, 1 Computer Science and 7 - Electives.
